NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS  
14<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE PAVEMENT REHABILITATION  
DREXEL TO MILWAUKEE**

Notice is hereby given that sealed proposals will be received in the office of the City Clerk of the City of South Milwaukee at the Administration Building, 2424 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue, South Milwaukee, WI 53172 **until 11:00 a.m. on Friday, June 10, 2022**, at which time they will be publicly opened and read for the above public works improvement contract which will include the following items of work:

- Concrete Curb & Gutter (Machine Placed) 1,010 L.F.
- Concrete Curb & Gutter (Spot Replacement) 1,400 L.F.
- Concrete Driveway Approach & Pavement 400 S.Y.
- Concrete Sidewalk & Ramps 4,500 S.F.
- Asphalt Pavement Milling 12,000 S.Y.
- Asphalt Surface 1,200 TONS
- Asphalt Base 1,900 TONS
- Quantities of unclassified excavation, base aggregate, barricades and manhole adjustments.
- Alternate Bid Quantities for 14<sup>th</sup> Avenue (Milwaukee to Rawson) including an additional 5,500 S.Y. of milling, 600 tons of surface, 525 L.F. of curb and other applicable quantities.

The document set describes items and quantities for bid proposal. It is anticipated that a contract will be awarded by the South Milwaukee Common Council by June 21, 2022 and the work shall be complete by October 1, 2022.

Document sets for bidding must be obtained from Quest. There is a non-refundable fee of forty (\$40) dollars per set.

Prequalification forms for 2022 are required to be on file in the Office of the City Engineer for all contractors and subcontractors at least seven (7) days prior to bid opening. Forms are available from the Engineer's Office upon request or on the City's website: <https://www.southmilwaukee.gov/DocumentCenter/View/239/Prequalification-Application-PDF>. The Common Council's decision as to qualification shall be final.

Proposal must be placed in a sealed opaque envelope addressed to: **“City Clerk, City of South Milwaukee, Wisconsin”** and marked **“Proposal for 2022 – 14<sup>th</sup> Avenue Pavement Rehabilitation, Drexel to Milwaukee”** If the bid is sent by mail, the sealed envelope shall be enclosed in a separate mailing envelope with the notation **“Sealed Bid Enclosed”** on the face thereof.

The City of South Milwaukee reserves the right to reject any or all bids and waive any informalities in the bidding. No bids shall be withdrawn after the opening of the bids without the consent of the City

of South Milwaukee, Wisconsin, for a period of thirty (30) days after the scheduled time for closing bids.

All proposals must be submitted on a form provided for that purpose as issued within the Document Set, together with a certified check or a bid bond not less than five (5%) percent of the bid, payable to the City of South Milwaukee as a guarantee that, if the bid accepted, the bidder will execute and file the contract and a performance bond in the amount of one hundred (100%) percent of the total proposal price within ten (10) working days after the award of the contract. Failure to execute such contract and performance bond shall be cause for forfeiture of the check or bid bond as liquidated damages.

This project is partially funded by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation through the Local Road Improvement Program (LRIP).
